## Tasting Notes

Aromas of lighter fruits, earth and baking spices with flavors of cherries strawberry, tobacco and leather. The fruit is bright with some lingering skin tannins from the extended maceration. This Spanish grape has a great future in Washington State

## Technical Notes

**Blend:** 86% Tempranillo 10% Grenache 4% Pinot Noir

**Harvest Date Avg:** October 17, 2008

**Harvest Chemistry Avg:** Brix: 25 Total Acidity: 4.9 g/L pH: 3.59

## Vinification

Destemmed and crushed to .5 ton fermenters, cold soaked for 3 days, followed by inoculated fermentation. Half of the lot was left for extended maceration, with the remainder co-fermented with the whole cluster Pinot Noir, and pressed near dryness. Aged on 20% new French oak, with twice yearly rackings. Light egg white fining prior to an unfiltered bottling.
